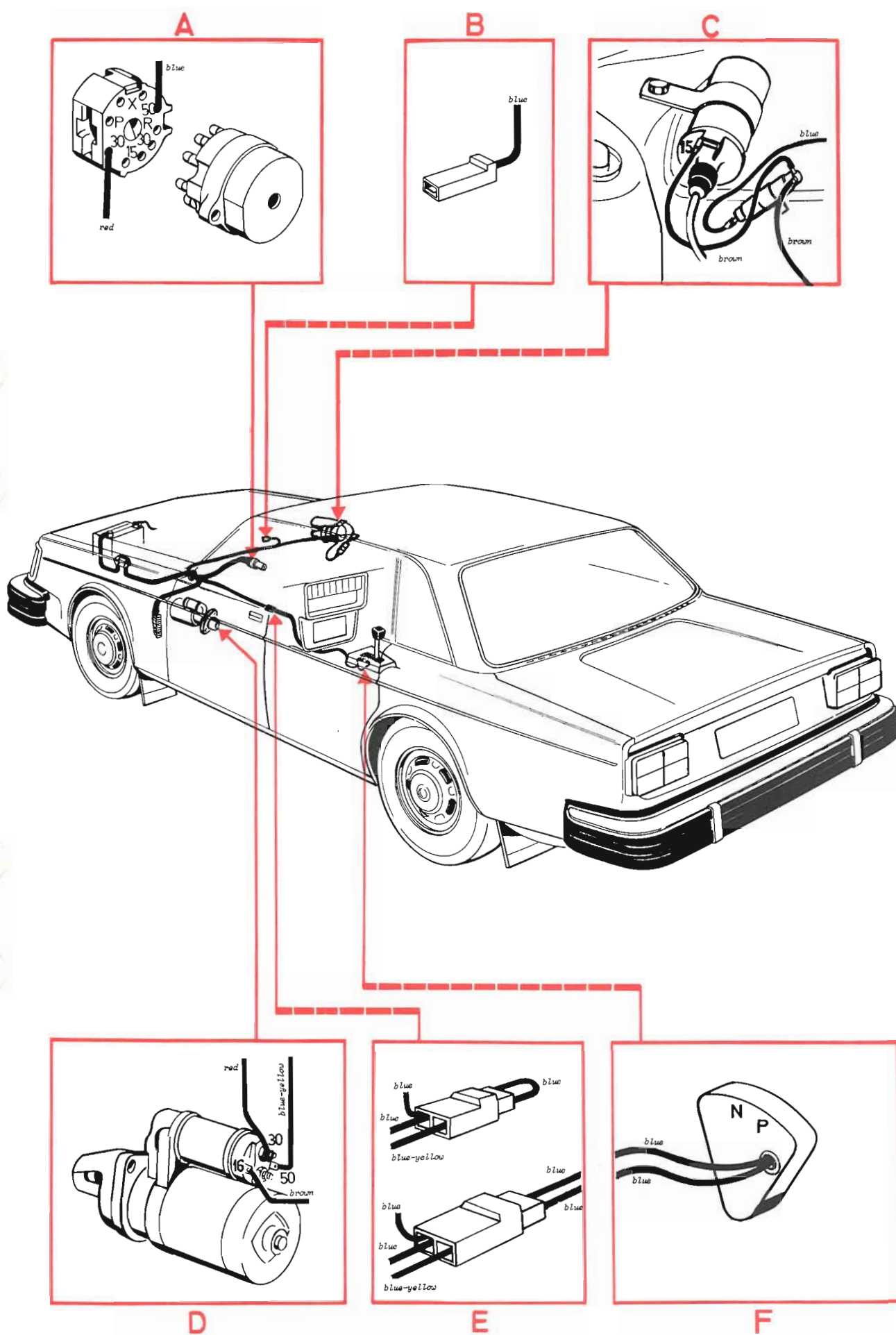
Ignition lock turned to ON position. Starter solenoid pushes pinion into contact with flywheel ring gear and also causes the solenoid contacts to close.



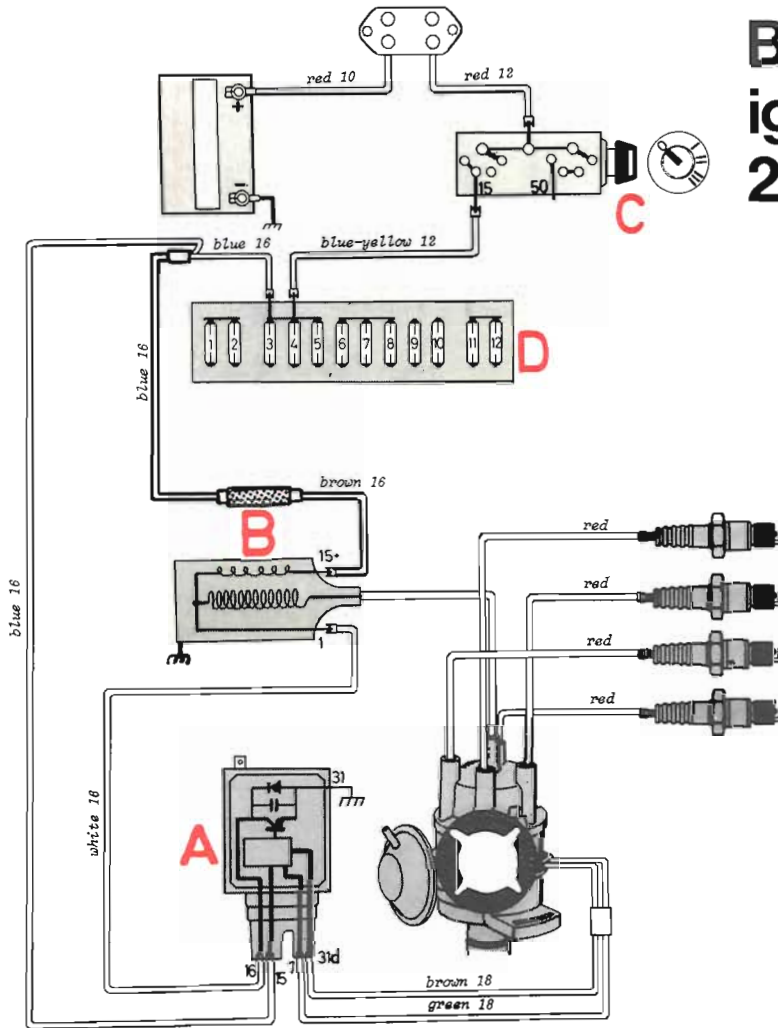
Starter motor operating

Solenoid contacts closed. Starter motor operates and cranks engine. Ignition coil voltage supplied from starter motor terminal 16.





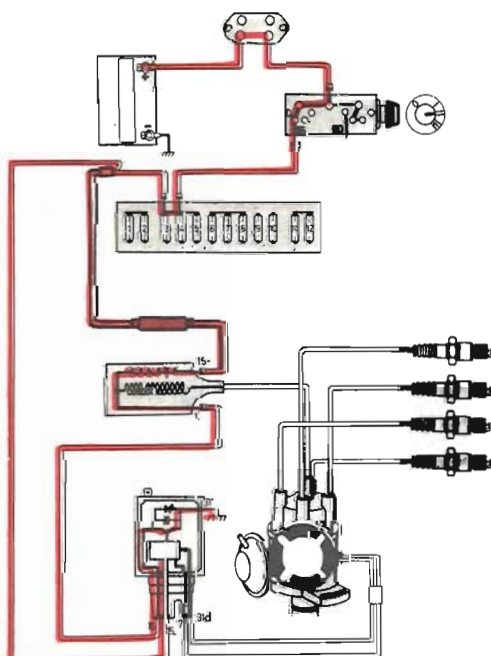
Breakerless electronic ignition system 240/1977 and 1978



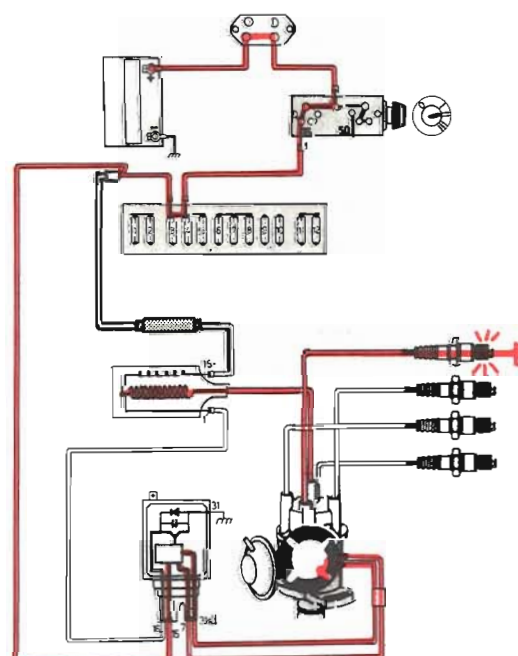

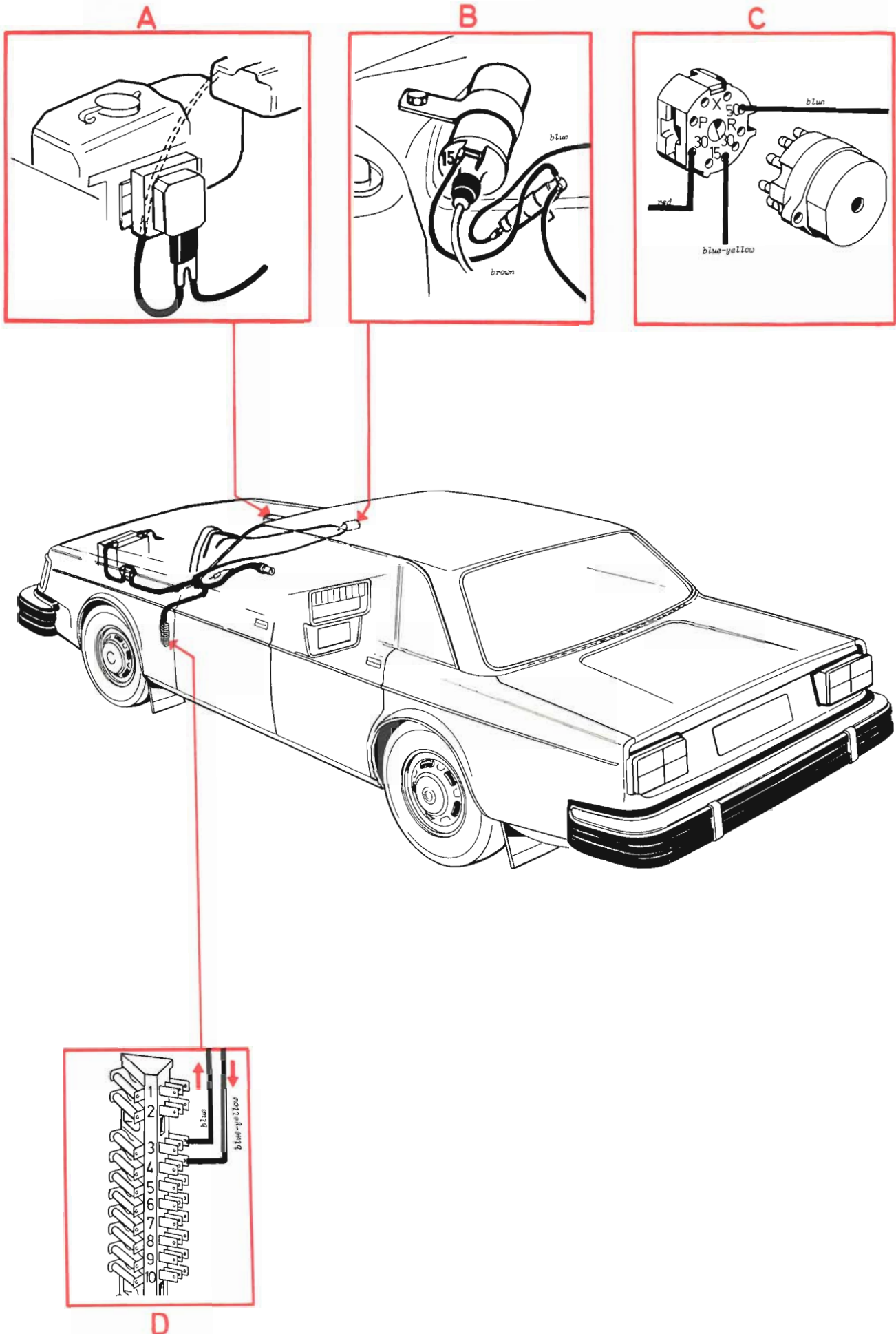

Current flows through electronic module, ignition coil primary winding is energized.

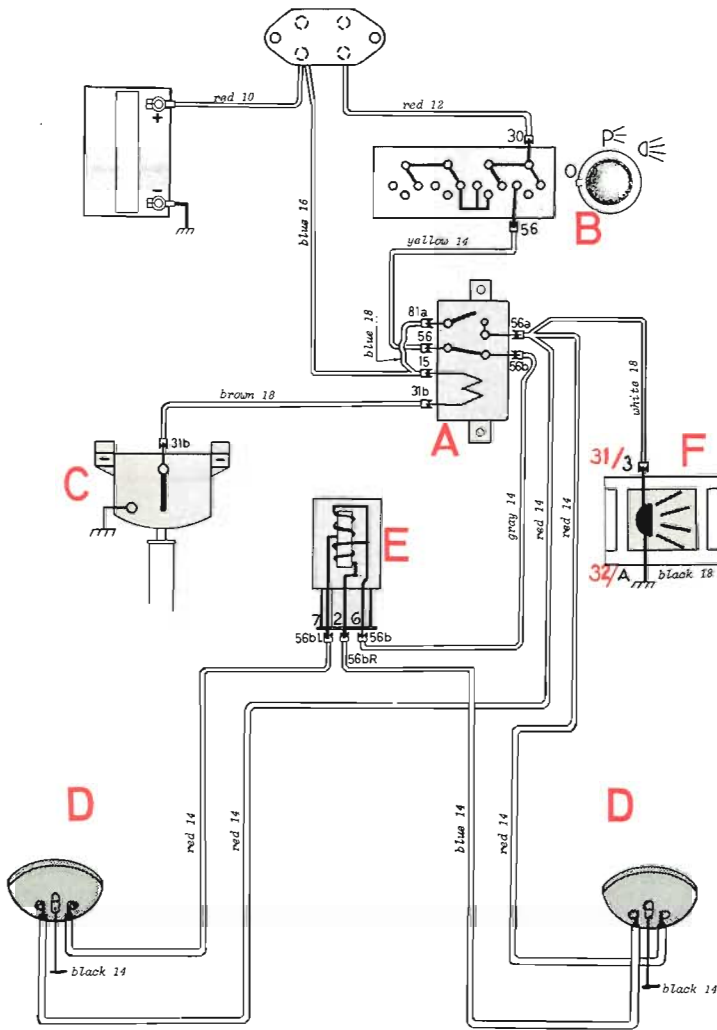




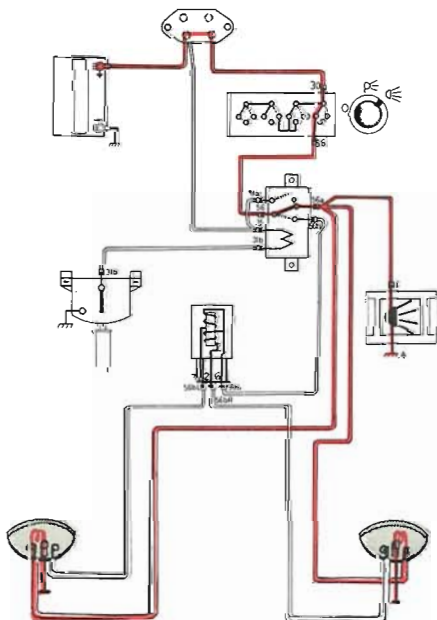

Relay and vacuum valve in speed regulator grounded through brake light bulbs.
Current is too small to illuminate brake lights.
Dotted lines indicate voltage below 12 V.



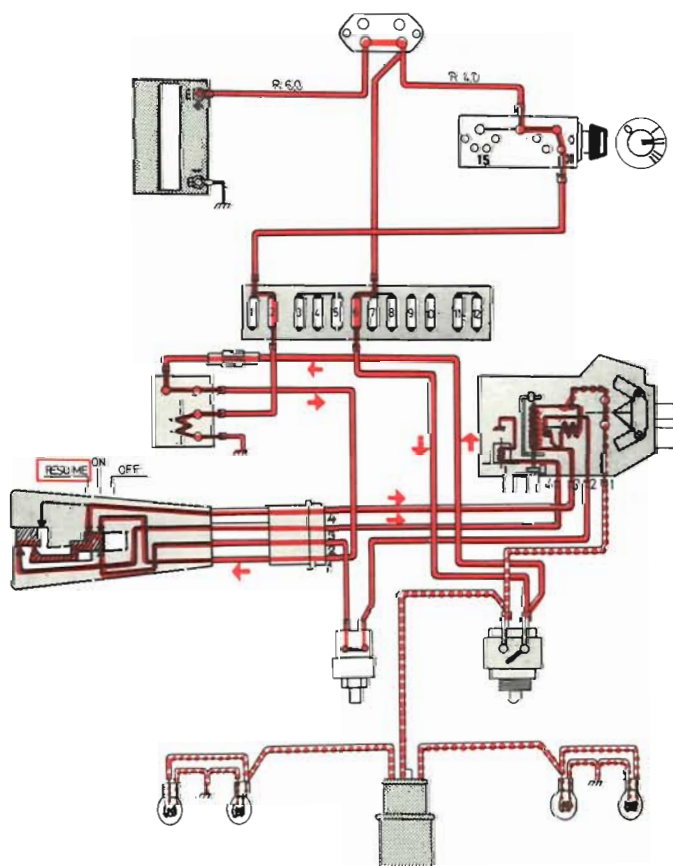

ON-impulse arrives at speed control terminal 3.
Speed control self-holding relay receives self-holding voltage through terminal 2 (provided speed is higher than 35 mph and brake and clutch not engaged).
Dotted lines indicate voltage below 12 V.



Cruise control disengaged

If brake pedal switch is engaged, the self-holding relay in the speed control will disengage (same voltage at both ends of coil). Memory retains previous speed setting.
